

The printed report 'Vulnerable through software. Lessons resulting from security breaches relating to Citrix software' contains two inaccuracies.

1. The summary on page 7 mentions the intelligence report from the General Intelligence and Security Service (AIVD) and the Military Intelligence and Security Service (MIVD) and the security advice of the AIVD. In error, it states that both the intelligence reports and the security advice came from the MIVD and the AIVD. This is incorrect, the intelligence report was from the AIVD and MIVD jointly, the security advice came from the AIVD.
2. Chapter 3.1.2 on page 54 discusses the intelligence report from the MIVD and AIVD, which 'identified an acute state actor threat aimed at an organization within national government'. This is incorrect, the perceived threat of the state actor was aimed at two organizations within national government.
